

# Service Preparation Checklist - Fleas

---



- **People and pets are required to be out during treatment and 3-4 hours after treatment.**
- **Pregnant women, infant children, people with respiratory problems, & small pets (birds, hamsters, etc.) should be out for 8 hours after treatment.**
- **Any aquariums need to be unplugged and covered with plastic.**
- **All loose articles should be removed from the floor , under beds, and from yard (clothes, shoes, luggage, boxes, children toys, etc).**
- **Vacuum all carpets and furniture thoroughly (including under cushions) before treatment and on a daily basis after treatment for one week. Add mothballs or a pet flea collar to vacuum bag to prevent fleas from escaping.**
- **Wash all bedding and pet beds in hot water and dry on high heat.**
- **Do not use any cleaners or detergents on treated floors, carpets, or upholstery for 2-3 weeks.**
- **It is normal to experience flea activity up to 25 days after treatment. The chemicals will affect the fleas when they emerge from the cacoon stage.**
- **Failure to comply with these requirements may void the service guarantee.**
